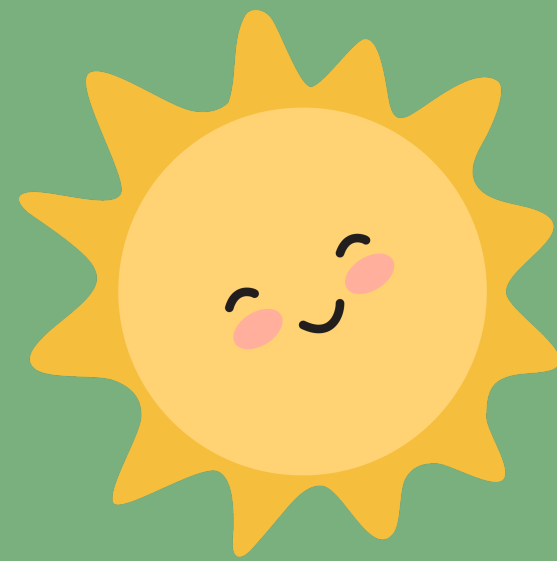




The Ku-ring-gai Tiny Forest Biodiversity Monitoring Statistics

After spending time in the Tiny Forest your mood improved by 20%



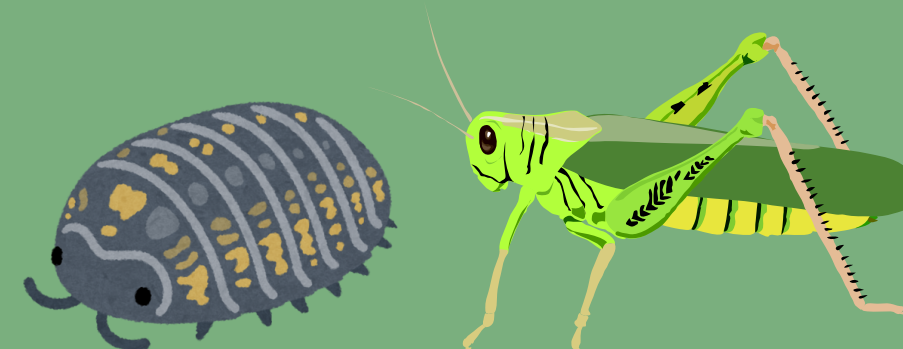
The tallest tree recorded was the Sydney Blue Gum at 0.78m tall
