Dear Resident

Bobbin Head Road, Pymble - Proposed Raised Pedestrian Crossing

Council is seeking your input on a proposal to replace the existing pedestrian refuge with a raised pedestrian (Wombat) crossing, and upgrade the street lighting on Bobbin Head Road, south of Selwyn Street.

Background

Council has received a request from Northside Montessori School to replace the existing pedestrian refuge on Bobbin Head Road with a pedestrian crossing. Pedestrian counts have been carried out at the site, and it was observed that a significant number of pedestrians used the existing refuge during morning and afternoon peak periods.

A Wombat Crossing would provide a much safer crossing point than the existing pedestrian refuge for the many school students that cross at this location. It would give pedestrians right of way when crossing the road, and would allow several people to cross the road at the same time. The raised crossing would also slow traffic along the school frontage.

Proposed changes

It is proposed that the existing pedestrian refuge be removed, and replaced with a Wombat Crossing. The works would also include an upgrade of the street lighting to meet current standards for a pedestrian crossing. The proposed changes are shown on the **attached** Plan *Bobbin/TDA/140/24*.
