Cleveland Street, Wahroonga - Proposed part-timed 'No Stopping' restrictions

Council is seeking your input on proposed part-time 'No Stopping' restrictions on Cleveland Street, as shown on the **attached** Plan No. *Cleveland/TDA26/25*.

Background

Council has received complaints from residents and Knox Grammar School about traffic congestion during afternoon pick-up time on Cleveland Street. It has been commented that road traffic is being blocked by vehicles looking for spaces to park.

Cleveland Street is in close proximity to a number of schools. The street is within walking distance from Wahroonga Train Station, leading to high demand for on-street parking.

During afternoon pick-up times, vehicles have frequently been parked on both sides of Cleveland Street between Billyard Avenue and Millewa Avenue. As a result, vehicles waiting to enter the 'KISS & RIDE' area in front of Knox Grammar School often queue back to the intersection with Billyard Avenue.

Parents picking up students on Billyard Avenue typically turn left onto Cleveland Street, merging with southbound traffic, while northbound traffic from Millewa Avenue also enters the street. This situation, combined with the existing parked vehicles, creates significant challenges for cars trying to pass each other. This has led to considerable traffic delays and congestion on Cleveland Street between the 'KISS & RIDE' Area and the Millewa Avenue intersection, necessitating traffic direction by Knox Grammar School teachers, which raises safety concerns.

Proposed changes

To mitigate this recurring issue, Council is proposing to install 'No Stopping 2:00pm – 3:30pm School Days' restrictions on the western side of Cleveland Street, between Millewa Avenue and the driveway to No. 8 Cleveland Street, Wahroonga. This will prevent parking during school pick-up time, thereby improving traffic flow in the vicinity.

Additionally, full-time 'No Stopping' restrictions will be implemented in Cleveland Street at the intersection with Millewa Avenue to prevent motorists from parking adjacent to the double centre lines and closer to the intersection.
