Howard Street, Lindfield - Proposed line marking

Council is seeking your input on a proposal to mark double centre lines around the bend in Howard Street, between Capper Street and Owen Street, as shown on the **attached** Plan *Howard/TDA/132/24*.

Background

There is a sharp bend on Howard Street, and it is difficult to see approaching vehicles from the opposite direction. Concerns have been raised about safety on the bend, due to the limited visibility.

Proposed changes

It is proposed that double centre lines be marked around the bend, to ensure that motorists remain on the correct side of the road, thereby minimising the risk of a collision.

It is illegal to park within 3 metres of double centre lines. Therefore, parking would not be permitted on the bend adjacent to the double centre lines.
