The Council's Community Strategic Plan 2032 identifies several priorities relevant to multicultural engagement:

- 1. C4 Diversity and inclusiveness: Harmonious communities that understand, value and accept each other, and embrace our evolving cultural identities.
- 2. C5 Creativity: Our creativity and rich cultural diversity is promoted and celebrated.

The June 2022 CSP Background paper offers several insights in this area, for instance one of the main challenges for the next 10 years included:
